

State Officer Selection Contingency Plan

Unfortunately, we are unable to hold the State Officer Selection process on 4/2-4/4/2020 as scheduled due to the COVID-19 outbreak. Below is an outline of how the State Officer Selection process will be facilitated this year.

We will be holding a modified version of this process on 4/25/2020. Instead of seven rounds, candidates will take the exam (ahead of time online on 4/24/2020), participate in the one on one, stakeholder, and personal rounds. These rounds will all happen on 4/25/2020. Unfortunately, due to the continued effects of the COVID-19 outbreak we have determined that we will not be facilitating the State Officer selection process in-person this year. **In place of in-person interviews this year, we will facilitate this process virtually on the same date, 4/25/2020.** The schedule will be as follows:
